- Food Pantry is August 20 & 27; There is a need for more volunteers. If you are interested, please call Linda Warner at 541-281-5535. The board meeting for the pantry is this Tuesday, August 13 at noon followed by stocking of the pantry. The July Food Bank was a great success. The July two Tuesday food pantries served 76 households, a total of 180 people (128 adults and 52 kiddos). Forty volunteers gave 150 hours. We also collected 31 pounds of extra food and dozens of non-food items to share with clients. The pantry needs toiletries for women and men (bath wash/soap, shampoo, deodorant, toothpaste) as well as feminine hygiene products.
