Klamath Falls Interfaith Food Pantry News

- Klamath Interfaith Food Pantry had its busiest month in October of 2024--at least 96 families were served. Nearly every morsel of food was distributed this month! The totals for October were 96 families served, a total of 199 adults and a total of 91 children. Forty-three volunteers put in 204 hours. And 600 pounds of food was donated. What a wonderful group of kind-hearted people!
- The Oregon Food Bank is experiencing a decrease in food supplies which "trickles down" to our local food bank and specifically Klamath Interfaith Food Pantry. Please consider purchasing and

donating the following foods. Do not at this time purchase toiletries as foods are of the most dire need.

Canned vegetables and fruit Tomato sauce, tomatoes, pasta sauce Pasta, rice, side dishes Canned/boxed soups Condiments (mayo, ketchup, mustard) Breakfast cereals Boxed milk – dairy, almond and oat – one quart size

- Klamath Interfaith Food Pantry's Thanksgiving Meal Box sign-up was a huge success—85 families requested these special meal boxes. Extra Volunteers are needed on November 19th (Tuesday) from 1-4 to organize the boxes and 5-6 to hand them out. Please contact Linda if you can volunteer 541-281-5535. The boxes need to be brought to the Klamath Falls Friends Church no later than November 17 (Sunday) with the name of the family clearly marked.
