Amount deposited: \$37,795

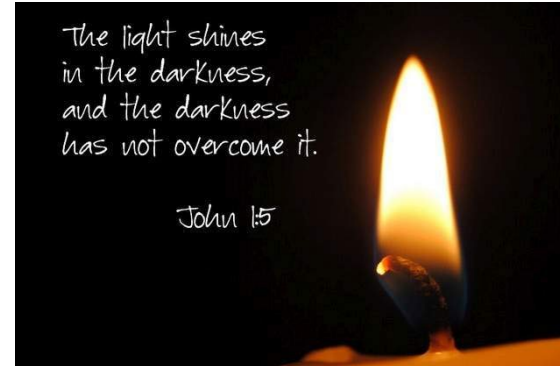
